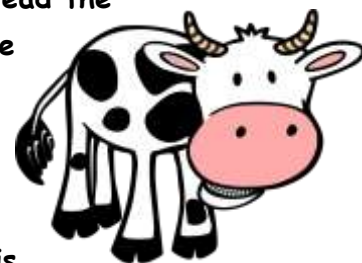
Welcome to PSJ Methodist church
