The money was given to 20 of the poorest families in the village to buy chickens, goats and health insurance for a year. Money from Bath churches enabled 8 widows to buy land to farm as a co-operative and an individual donation bought a keyboard for the church. Please keep praying for the church there – they are praying for us. Sue gave one of her paintings of our church to take to them and they were thrilled to have this.
