### **Somer Valley Foodbank**

Somer Valley Foodbank would like to thank all of you who continue to contribute, your donations can still be received at The Meeting Place. The foodbank and the Trussell Trust use many different distribution centres, and it is their responsibility to maintain safety in them while they are open. They are reminding all centres that, during the present Covid 19 emergency, only staff should enter the premises while they are open, and if anyone other than clients need to enter the premises, they must check-in using the Foodbank QR code (not the church one). This enables Check & Trace if needed.

If you would like to donate items, there is a collection point at the Meeting Place. The current list of items required is: Biscuits, Brown Sauce, Chocolates, Corned beef, Custard, Instant mash, Jam, Ketchup, Macaroni cheese, Meat soup, Milk powder, Potatoes (tinned), Sponge puddings and other puddings, Savoury snacks, Spaghetti (tinned), Sweets, Sweet snacks, Toothbrushes (adults & children's), Toothpaste (children's) and Household multi-purpose cleaner.
