Sun	25	Palm Sunday: Lord, help us in this Holy Week to reflect on your journey to the cross.
Mon	26	We lift to you, Father, our temptations as Jesus did when he was tempted.
Tues	27	We bring to you, Father, our service this evening : Stations of the cross
Wed	28	Show us the way, Father, to spread the ‘Good News of Jesus’
Thurs	29	Maundy Thursday: we remember Jesus and His friends at the Last Supper
Fri	30	Good Friday: Thank you Jesus for your love on the cross saving us from our sins. May the Walk of Witness speak to all who see it.
Sat	31	Help us Lord to really take on board what you have done for us.
Sun	1	Easter Day: The Lord is Risen! Hallelujah! Mark 16:6 “Don’t be alarmed” He said. You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. HE HAS RISEN”
Mon	2	2 Corinthians 5:14 -15 And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again.
Tues	3	Hebrews 12:2 For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
Wed	4	Father, bless those who pray and those who don't, especially those yet to experience the love of God and the power of prayer.
Thurs	5	We lift to you, Lord, the Lighthouse group. We pray for those working with and on behalf of children & youth. May many young people be open to your word.
Fri	6	Thank God for lighter evenings! We praise you Jesus for the beauty of spring.
Sat	7	Saturday breakfast: we pray for all involved in the preparation and for those who enjoy the food! Strictly questions: we pray, Lord, that you are at the centre of the discussions this evening.
Sun	8	God be in my head and in my understanding.
Mon	9	God be in my eyes and in my looking.
Tues	10	God be in my mouth and in my speaking.
Wed	11	God be in my heart and in my thinking.
Thurs	12	God be at my end and at my departing.
Fri	13	Messy church: we pray that all the children have fun but also leave, having learned something of you, Jesus.
Sat	14	May we remember, Lord, that prayers can’t be answered unless brought before you.
Sun	15	Help us to use your commandments as stepping stones to you, Father.
Mon	16	Praise you Lord for all the people going to prayer breakfast this morning.
Tues	17	We pray for the Aldersgate team visiting in May. Guide them, Lord, in their preparation.
Wed	18	Please help us, Father, to recognise the needs of others at all times.
Thurs	19	Midsomer Norton Filling Station: we pray that you will speak to those attending.
Fri	20	We praise and thank you Lord for your still small voice. Help us to be still and wait.
Sat	21	Ephesians 4:32 Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ, God forgave you.
