JMA Awards - Sunday 17th November

JMA awards will be presented during the morning service on Sunday 17th November. JMA (Junior Mission for All) is part of the Methodist Church's mission programme. Children and young people raise money to support the Methodist Church's World Mission Fund and Mission in Britain Fund. Last year, JMA collectors raised well over £97,000. Of this, 80% went to the World Mission Fund to help 60 Partner Churches in Africa, Europe, Latin America, the Caribbean, Asia and the Pacific. The other 20% supported Methodist mission projects across the UK.
