Youth Worker

It is with disappointment that we have to announce that our village youth worker, Chris Scolah, will shortly be moving on to pastures new. Chris started in his role right in the middle of the lockdown last year and so his outreach work has been heavily impacted as a result, however, he has been key in the opening of the Hive and has been able to commence active youth work more recently. We thank God for Chris' ministry in the village and send our blessings for his future.

We are now looking to appoint a new youth worker to replace Chris. This post is part-time as the village youth worker and part-time as a team leader for Bath Youth for Christ. Please pass on the details to anyone who might be interested.

This exciting role is in partnership with the Methodist Church, St John's Church and St Joseph's Catholic Church. The postholder will be responsible for developing existing connections with the community, develop and deliver regular drop-in sessions, and develop links with local schools to offer resources. The postholder will also have responsibility for the line management of youth & schools workers delivering other Bath Youth for Christ projects.

There is a Genuine Occupational Requirement that the post-holder is a committed and practicing Christian.

Green Tip of the Week

2. **Have a meat-free couple of days** – Raising animals for meat produces a large amount of greenhouse gases even reducing by 28% (2 days out of 7) would make a difference. Have you tried the roasted vegetable jacket at the Meeting Place? – Yummy!
3. **Mowing your lawn** – Think whether you need to mow all the lawn or could you leave some areas longer for insects and pollinators who are having a hard time.
